Greg Phillips created CenterStage at the Osher Marin JCC (the San Francisco Bay Area's 92nd St. Y) in 1991. As CenterStage Director for 15 seasons he presented over 600 performances and events.

CenterStage's Singers & Songwriters series brought many of the American Musical Theatre's greatest performers and songwriters to the Bay Area.

In the acclaimed Artists & Authors series, that featured the likes of Neil Simon, Carl Reiner, Theodore Bikel and Tommy Tune, Phillips did on-stage interviews with Kristin Chenoweth, Charles Honi Coles, Thomas Keller,

Tony Kushner and Gary Marshall.

In 1995, he founded CSTAR, Creative Stage Artists Management, and during the past 10 years represented songwriter Stephen Schwartz and Broadway's Marin Mазzie, Jason Danieley, Liz Callaway and Jason Graae.

In his early years, in the Bay Area, he created a unique musical theatre and arts program for the San Anselmo and Fairfax school districts and was Director of Youth Programs for the Marin Symphony.

His work in television and film includes hosting and producing the first-ever home remodeling series, KQED's Grin and Repair It (the forerunner to This Old House) and coaching Robin Williams for his role as the Russian saxophonist in *Moscow on the Hudson*.
