Rotary International is a volunteer organization of business and professional leaders who provide humanitarian service, and help to build goodwill and peace in the world.

There are approximately 1.2 million Rotary club members belonging to more than 32,000 Rotary clubs in more than 200 countries and geographical areas.

Founded in Chicago in 1905, Rotary celebrated 100 years of service in 2005.

During the past 60 years, The Rotary Foundation has awarded more than US\$1.1 billion in humanitarian and educational grants, which are administered at the local level.

What is the purpose of Rotary?

Rotary clubs exist to improve communities locally and around the world. Rotary also encourages high ethical standards in business and professions.

Rotary clubs work to advance international understanding by partnering with clubs in other countries.
