Donna Baranski-Walker is the Executive Director for the Rebuilding Alliance. Being part of a super-innovative team and building positive direct action to challenge the status quo of war – that is what Donna cares about.

Peace work comes from a deep place with her: she grew up with a sister who was disabled and learned from the start that it is what is on the inside, not outside appearance, that truly matters.

Donna founded the Rebuilding Alliance in 2003, and before that she worked with Jeff Halper of ICAHD and Ziad Hamouri of JCSER to launch the Global

Campaign to Rebuild Palestinian Homes. She's worked at SRI International, at Stanford University, and at M.I.T. in technology licensing and business development.

She is proud of her perseverance (needed to launch a nonprofit start-up) and holds a B.S. from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology and an M.S. from the Univer-
