The San Carlos City Council endorsed this decision and formally approved City participation in the effort at their September 29, 2005 meeting.

They also authorized the City Finance Department to establish an account for donations to Pass Christian at that meeting.

To start the donation process, Deputy City Manager Jeff Maltbie presented \$500 from the City of San Carlos employees during that City Council meeting.

Pass Christian is a town of about 14,000, including the surrounding areas, which was flooded by Hurricane Katrina.
