John Tenvold, SC Rotary President 1962-63

John F. Tenvold John passed away June 30th at the age of 91. He was born and raised in Minneapolis and attended the Univ. of Minn. As a boy, he often spent his summers on Spyder Island and the winters ice boating on his homemade boats. Anticipating WWII, John enlisted in the U.S. Navy and was in flight training at Pensacola when Pearl Harbor was attacked. After receiving his wings, John transferred to the Marine Corps and was sent to Guadalcanal, flying close air support for the landing troops and later assigned to an escort/jeep carrier, the U.S.S. Vella Gulf (CVE 111). John's aviator flight logbook indicates he had qualified on over a dozen different aircraft including the Grumman F3F, F4F Wildcat, F6F Hellcat, SBD Dauntless and his favorite the

Vought F4U Corsair. John and men like him were true saviors to infantrymen struggling in the coral wastelands of places like Peleliu and the volcanic ash of Iwo Jima. "Know why I don't have any hair?" he would ask his kids. "That's what happens when you land your airplane on a sandy beach, upside down with the canopy open." John had many stories including how he first met, and later became Major Gregory (Pappy) Boyington's wingman for a
