Jeffrey Bass, new Hiller CEO, to speak July 27

Jeffrey Bass is the new CEO of the Hiller Aviation Institute and Museum in San Carlos, the museum's board and Chairman Steve Hiller announced.

Bass replaced interim CEO Dan Putman, a co-founder of Adobe Systems, who will return to his regular responsibilities on Hiller's board of directors.

Putman had been filling in since former CEO Alan Waufle (also formerly a member of the Rotary Club of San Carlos), who had been at the helm since October 2002, stepped down at the end of July 2006 and moved to Florida.

Bass was the vice president of education, public programs and IMAX at the Milwaukee Public Museum, which

focuses on natural history and science.

For 18 years prior, he was the director of planetarium and astronomy programs for the Cranbrook Institute of Science in Bloomfield Hills, Mich.

There, he developed exhibits and programs for a \$31 million museum expansion, including an aviation academy, and served as the museum's operations officer.
