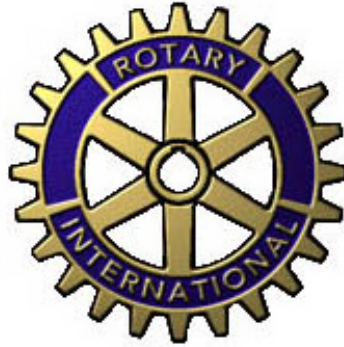

Steve Holmstrom Speaks of the Fleet at Suisun Bay

Steve Holmstrom is a member of the Rotary Club of San Carlos.

His first service to the club was to serve as the pancake feed “master batter mixer” for 2006. His skill in this “event” was obtained by mixing endodontic materials!

In all seriousness, he currently practices at the Animal Dental Clinic in San Carlos, California, having been certified by the American Veterinary Dental College (AVDC) 1989.

At this time, there are only 91 Board Certified Veterinary Dentists certified by the AVDC and only about half are in private practice in the US.

He earned his DVM degree from the University of Missouri in 1972.

He is the past president of the American Veterinary Dental College, Academy of Veterinary Dentistry, American Veterinary Dental Society and two times president for the Peninsula Veterinary Medical Association.

He has consulted for the National Aeronautics and Space Administration Ames Research Center and University of California at Berkeley’s Office of Lab Animal Care.
