Ben Drew to Speak on Palo Alto Medical Foundation

The Palo Alto Medical Foundation (PAMF) is proposing to build a new San Carlos Campus consisting of a Medical Clinic, Hospital, and Medical Office building at 301 Industrial Road.

Communications & Power Industries, Inc. (CPI). The property contains about 18.1 acres or 788,100 square feet.

The buildings on the campus will contain 478,500 square feet of floor area.

The following list shows the size of the hospital, medical clinic, medical office and central plant. All of the buildings total 478,500 square feet.

The hospital is proposed to accommodate 110 beds. The facility is designed to accommodate 180 physicians and 1,137 staff for a total employee count of 1,450.

The buildings are proposed to be stepped with each succeeding story smaller than the one below.

The maximum height of the complex would be 91 feet. An architectural tower feature would be 100' tall. A total of 1,377 parking spaces are planned on the site to support the complex.

There will be two parking structures, each four stories in height containing a combined total of 1,245 spaces.

The parking structures will be located on each side of the main building. There will be an additional 131 surface spaces around the complex.
