Doctors of World Vision. In 1998 it was changed to International Vision Volunteers (IVV). The IVV Facilities are located adjacent to the Zimba Wesleyan Mission Hospital in Zambia Africa.

Many children in Zambia are born with cataracts, due to the mother having measles during pregnancy, poor nutrition, other diseases, and for unexplained reasons. Others develop cataracts during the first few months of life secondary to malnutrition, measles, diseases, and trauma. It is important that we do surgery as soon as possible so that they do not develop amblyopian (lazy eye) in one or both eyes. To sponsor a child for cataract surgery costs approx \$75/eye opposed to \$5000-\$10000/eye in the US. A donation of \$75 would truly be giving a child a life that would never have much of one otherwise. Indeed if surgery is not done the family might not take as good care and let the child die. The surgery is subsidized by the surgeon, nurses, ancillary help, pharmaceutical, and instrumental companies, along with many others. The donation of time, supplies, and equipment parallels what it would be in the US. (*Visit website-Ed.*)
