## Endowment Surges To Highest Level

Bolstered by a contribution of \$12,000 from the San Carlos Rotary Club Board, the Endowment Fund, established back in 2000, has eclipsed \$300,000, reported Endowment member Don Whitley at last Friday's luncheon meeting.

The Endowment was formed to ultimately provide funding for educationally enriched programs and activities directly benefiting the development of the young people of San Carlos and other community residents.

“This plateau has been achieved with generous contributions from Club members and prudent investing of those funds,” Don said.
