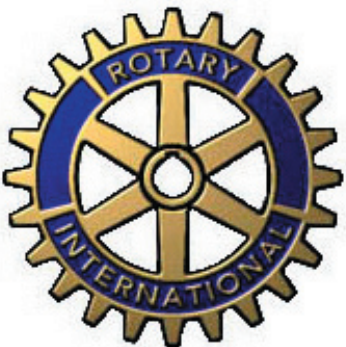

At 94 years young, **Forbes King** is a tireless worker for youth and the disadvantaged. He has been an active volunteer since 1976 (while still working in real estate). He managed Rotary's Pre-School Children's Immunization Program. He tutors through the Healthy Schools Project.

During the holidays he collects toys and money for abused and neglected children. He led a successful drive to collect computers for Juvenile Hall and the Women's Jail. He is also involved in a program that provides tattoo removal for gang members who want out.

We salute Rotarian **Forbes King** and see him as a role model for Rotarians in District 5150.
