Walking for Ben to Fight Leukemia

District 5150 co-sponsored "Walking for
Ben" on October 8, 2005. This fundraiser
is organized by dedicated Rotarian Jim
McGovern of the Belmont Club. Jim is
officially a member of the Belmont Club
but attends the San Carlos, Redwood City,
and other Peninsula Rotary Clubs on a
regular basis.

Jim lost his two-year old grandson Ben
to Leukemia. He has now organized two
fundraisers to collect money to pay salaries
for researchers in the hope that they will
discover a cure for Leukemia. All the
money collected goes into the researchers'
salaries since Jim pays for all the
administrative costs of the Walking for Ben
event. The Walk in District 5150 raised
over \$255,000. It was done in conjunction
with Light the Night – another Leukemia
fundraiser.

Eight hundred people turned out to walk.
Rotarians "Walking for Ben" raised over
half of the money. Combined with the
results of a second "Walking for Ben" held
in the San Jose area– over \$500,000 was
collected for Leukemia research.

The Rotary Clubs of Foster City and
San Francisco Bayview fed the crowd.
Foster City provided the famous Ollieque
organized by Ollie Pattum and San
Francisco Bayview led by Tom Chasm
provided chili. Boy, did they cook! See

this event. Good work, Jim, - and all of
you who supported him.
