Vargas' background includes ownership of her own interior decorating business over the past 29 years, membership in her local Chamber of Commerce and many volunteer and later professional positions organizing community and countywide campaigns.

Her most notable efforts over the past 10 years include management of successful ballot measure campaigns in support of the construction of a tunnel at Devil's Slide (Measure T in 1996) and the expansion of the boundaries of the Midpeninsula Regional Open Space District to include the entire San Mateo County Coastside (Measure F in 1997).

In February of 2005 the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors appointed Vargas to serve on the County's Agricultural Advisory Committee. She is also an elected member of the San Mateo County Democratic Central Committee and represents all Democrats living in District 3, which includes the City of San Carlos.
