After graduation I worked in rural Bolivia with the organization, Amigos de las Americas doing community development.

I then worked for two years at the American International School of Bolivia as a second, third, and fourth grade teacher and directed the high school community service program.

I returned to California to get my teaching credential.

In between the credential program, I worked in rural Honduras as the director of a 58 person volunteer program for three months in 21 communities.
