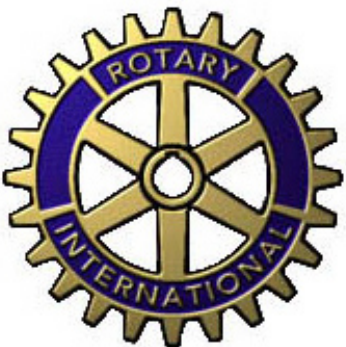

Pacifica Rotarians to Speak at San Carlos Rotary

 When Marilyn St. Germain-Hall and Patrick Hall set their minds to helping others they make a long-term commitment that doesn't quit at the end of the day. The husband-and-wife duo recently returned from a trip to Ecuador where they participated in a Rotary Club International project. While they were the only people from Pacifica who went on the trip, about 500 people, including local Rotary district leaders, attended the Rotary International project fair in

the Ecuadorian city of Cuenca. Typically, a Rotary Club in a developing nation such as Ecuador will pitch projects to the people from the developed countries and entice them to become involved.
