## Al Teglia to speak at Rotary Club Luncheon

Al Teglia was born in 1931 in the Colma, California. His family moved to Daly City when Al was in his teenage years where Al attended and graduated from Jefferson High School, going on to enroll in the College of San Mateo, receiving a degree in horticulture. Upon graduation, Al went to work for the San Mateo Union High School District. He retired as Operations Manager in 1989 after 38 years, then the longest tenured employee in the School District. Al went on to work as the legislative aide to the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors.

Al Teglia is also former mayor of Daly City. He now works with the Human Services Agency as advocate for children and families.
