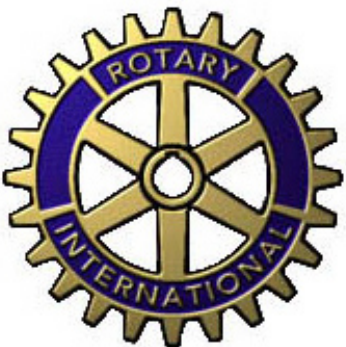

Ian McAvoy joined San Mateo County Transit District (SamTrans) in 1992 and was appointed Chief Development Officer in April 2004. He oversees a full-service development organization that includes strategic planning, business development, transportation / environmental planning, project funding, program planning, grants, capital budgets, engineering, project management, construction, rail maintenance, external relations, legislative affairs, property development / TOD functions

and the administration of a sales tax authority that provides funding to highway and transit programs.

Before joining SamTrans, Mr. McAvoy held positions in the finance and planning professions. He was educated at Heriot-Watt / Edinburgh University in Scotland

SamTrans has partnered with the San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit District (BART) to operate BART's San Francisco International Airport extension.
