In 2004, Carol was recruited to handle  
all Outreach, Community Based  
Programming, Communications and  
Special Programs for the Office of the  
Chief Elections Officer & Assessor-  
County Clerk-Recorder. One of her  
primary responsibilities in that capacity  
was to explore new ways to build  
community coalitions and leverage  
existing community strengths to engage  
previously underrepresented populations  
into the democratic process.

She created California's first Poll Worker  
Training Academy held at Menlo College  
which was recognized by the National

Association of Election Officials and she  
assisted in the production of California's  
first real time election coverage show for  
public TV. She produced a television  
commercial which featured school  
children encouraging adults to register  
and vote.

The commercial was borne out of a  
classroom experiential learning exercise  
in how Democracy and voting really  
works. As a former teacher, Marks  
recognized the power of authentic  
student voices and wanted students to  
carry the message about the importance  
of voting to the adult world.

Carol spends much of her time working  
with community groups, the press,  
legislators and others to bring about  
election reform through creative, new  
legislative endeavors.

This fall, she and her staff have begun  
the introduction of the new eSlate voting  
equipment to the voters of San Mateo  
County. That's why she's here today.
